We want YOU to JOIN 40 WEEKS!

JOIN THE 40 WEEKS TEAM. We will work together, pray together, learn together, and have fun together. **OUR MISSION:** Serve, love, and build relationships with the children of our community.

A 40-week commitment means you will:

- be an important adult in the lives of the children, work to build your relationship with them in order to earn their trust and assist in the development of their faith
- show up consistently and on time to build relationships with Harvest Families
- serve every Sunday during the school year (that you are not sick or out of town)
- meet 30 mins. prior to the start of Harvest Kids (8:30am or 10:00am) to pray with one another, encourage each other, and build community over coffee and donuts, get the space ready, and begin to greet early arrivers
- come Sunday morning prepared and work together to support one another
- attend weekly worship at Harvest the hour that you are not serving

Why 40 Weeks?

- **Because faith formation matters.** How can we get 3rd graders to open up and trust someone with their confusing questions about God if they have a new leader each week? We want to be there for those children as they ask those tough questions.
- **Because consistency matters.** Pouring into the heart and life of a child over a consistent period of time is powerful! If you only get to work with these children for less than an hour one Sunday a month, your influence is limited. Imagine seeing that child every Sunday! Imagine the connection you can form!
- **Because family matters.** Partnering with families over time means building relationships that make a difference and builds up the Body of Christ.
- Because you matter. You have amazing gifts that you can share with the children in our community.
- **Because going to church matters.** When you show up consistently, children and their families show up more frequently because they know you will be there and they want to spend time with you.



COMMIT TO A JOB!

JOB: SMALL GROUP LEADER

Small Group Leaders: 25 fun and committed leaders who care about forming faith in children!

- We give you an easy to use lesson plan, a schedule, and materials. You will receive regular training, encouragement and support.
- You get to build relationships with children as you lead them through the lesson plan and schedule.
- Review your weekly lesson plan, read through the Bible story, and practice any activities before you arrive on Sunday morning so that way you come prepared.
- Arrive 30 minutes early to pray with the team, find out important need to know information for the morning, get your space ready, and greet early arrivers.
- Show up consistently during the school year (missing only when you are sick or out of town).
- Work in a team of 2-4 other adults so that you are never alone with the children
- 25 committed, consistent leaders ensure that we will have space to care weekly for up to 125 children!

JOB: LARGE GROUP LEADER

Large Group Leaders: 10 dramatic and excited youth/adults who love telling the stories of the Bible!

- If you enjoy theatrics, dancing, and worship this is the job for you!
- It is your job to tell and review the Bible Story, lead the children in prayer and guide them in worship.
- You will work with youth and children to tell the Bible Story in a creative way, to get children excited about worshipping the Lord, and to help us to center our hearts in prayer.
- You will receive the scripts the week before and we will meet weekly to rehearse together.
- Arrive 30 minutes prior to the start of the service to pray together and rehearse before Large group.
- Trainings and rehearsals will be provided to equip leaders for their stage debut!

JOB: WELCOME TEAM MEMBER

Welcome Team Member: 10 friendly and welcoming adults who love to smile

- If you are unsure about serving in the classroom but are eager to serve new families, this is the job for you!
- Arrive 30 mins prior to service in order to welcome and greet families and guests and direct them to where they are supposed to go, walking guests to their age-appropriate classroom.
- Host the Check-in hub stations to assist new families learn how to check-in. You will be properly trained on this easy and efficient check-in system.

JOB: FLOATER

Floater: 5 people who will show up and help in many different ways
