A Way Other than Our Own

I ran across a Lenten devotional by this name a few weeks ago. Lent, after all, is an invitation into a way other than our own – it's an invitation into the way of the Kingdom of God. I was completely captivated by this phrase and I hope it will resonate in my imagination throughout this season of Lent. For I want to pursue the ways of Jesus – the ways that call me to love people. I'm interested in loving – in the ways that call me to lay aside my preferences for the sake of the body of Christ, and the ways that call me to slow, abiding presence with others – when I would rather do my own thing.

This Lent, the people of Harvest are invited into this journey of a way other than our own as we explore the stories of the Gospel in our worship series *Think Again.* Jesus never does what we expect; he's always interested in turning our thinking upside down; Jesus is always interested in inviting us into the strange ways of his kingdom. It's an invitation to lay aside our own assumptions, our own preferences, our own consumerism, and to instead think again about who and whose we are. So that the world might see in us something different, something strange, something new – and see in us the story of the Gospel.

You're also invited to join us on Wednesday evenings as we pray, sing, and dialogue together using *The Shack* by William Young. The book walks through deep theological truths, stretches the imagination of who God is and how God relates to us. It should also be an invitation into a way other than our own.

No matter how you mark this season of Lent, I pray you'll join me in this journey, this way, this path of the kingdom of God. Allow God to be at work in you, reshaping you, inviting you to think again, catching you off guard, making you new creation (1Cor 5:12). Let us together walk the way that is not our own.


