Weekly Opportunities:

These are for people who want to volunteer every week and develop a strong relationship with a teacher and/or student.

- 1) Reading Pals
- 2) Mentor students: Meet students at lunchtime to have lunch and chat
 - a. Kindergarten 11:55-12:25
 - b. First grade 12:05-12:35
 - c. Second grade 10:55 -11:25
 - d. Third grade 11:35- 12:05
 - e. Fourth grade 11:05- 11:35
 - f. Fifth grade 10:45- 11:15
- 3) Specials teachers: Art, music, science
 - a. Volunteers for weekend Sierra Club trips
 - b. Library: any day, anytime for shelving, reading to kids, monitoring check
- 4) Kindergarten teachers seek volunteers up to 5 for each time:
 - a. 8:30-9:25: Computers extended day
 - b. 9:25-10:25: Math, work with students
 - c. 10:25-11:55: ELA- work with students
 - d. 12:45- 1:45: writing work with students
 - e. During this time, filing or making crafts with students for holidays is also welcome.
- 5) 1st grade - 5 Harvest volunteers every Friday from 12:00 - 1:30.
- 6) 2nd grade - Any day clerical or reading with students in the afternoon
